

## Bible Verses - Jehovah Witness

### **John 1:1-3 (NKJV)**

<sup>1</sup> In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

<sup>2</sup> He was in the beginning with God.

<sup>3</sup> All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

### **John 1:1-3 (NWT)**

<sup>1</sup> In the beginning the Word was, and the Word was with God, and the Word was a god.

<sup>2</sup> This one was in the beginning with God.

<sup>3</sup> All things came into existence through him, and apart from him not even one thing came into existence.

(Commentary: A) If the Word, Jesus, is a god, is He a true god or a false god?"

B) If Jesus is a created being, how did He create everything, when He is part of creation?)

### **Psalm 102:1 (NKJV)**

1 Hear my prayer, O LORD, And let my cry come to You.

### **Psalm 102:22-27 (NKJV)**

22 When the peoples are gathered together, And the kingdoms, to serve the LORD.

23 He weakened my strength in the way; He shortened my days.

24 I said, "O my God, Do not take me away in the midst of my days; Your years *are* throughout all generations.

25 Of old You laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens *are* the work of Your hands.

26 They will perish, but You will endure; Yes, they will all grow old like a garment; Like a cloak You will change them, And they will be changed.

27 But You *are* the same, And Your years will have no end.

### **Hebrews 1:8-12 (NKJV)**

8 But to the Son *He says: "Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom.*

9 *You have loved righteousness and hated lawlessness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of gladness more than Your companions."*

10 And: *"You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens are the work of Your hands.*

11 *They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment;*

12 *Like a cloak You will fold them up, And they will be changed. But You are the same, And Your years will not fail."*

(Commentary: Psalm 102 talks about Yahweh and Hebrews talks about Jesus)

### **John 12:39-43 (NKJV)**

39 Therefore they could not believe, because Isaiah said again:

40 *"He has blinded their eyes and hardened their hearts, Lest they should see with their eyes, Lest they should understand with their hearts and turn, So that I should heal them."*

41 These things Isaiah said when he saw His glory and spoke of Him.

42 Nevertheless even among the rulers many believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they did not confess *Him*, lest they should be put out of the synagogue;

43 for they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God.

### **Isaiah 6:10 (NKJV)**

10 *"Make the heart of this people dull, And their ears heavy, And shut their eyes; Lest they see with their eyes, And hear with their ears, And understand with their heart, And return and be healed."*

(Commentary: Isaiah talks about Yahweh and John talks about Jesus)

## Bible Verses - Jehovah Witness

### **Jeremiah 23:5-6 (NKJV)**

<sup>5</sup> "Behold, *the* days are coming," says the LORD, "That I will raise to David a Branch of righteousness; A King shall reign and prosper, And execute judgment and righteousness in the earth.

<sup>6</sup> In His days Judah will be saved, And Israel will dwell safely; Now this *is* His name by which He will be called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

(Commentary: Jesus is the branch of David, and in the original hebrew, "LORD" is translated from the word Yahweh. It is blasphemy to use the title "Yahweh" or "LORD")

### **Isaiah 7:14 (NKJV)**

<sup>14</sup> Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

(Commentary: Immanuel means "god with us". So is Jesus God, a god, or something else?)

### **Isaiah 9:6 (NKJV)**

<sup>6</sup> For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.

(Commentary: Jesus is call Mighty God.)

### **John 1:14 (NKJV)**

<sup>14</sup> And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

### **Colossians 1:13-18 (NKJV)**

<sup>13</sup> He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed *us* into the kingdom of the Son of His love,

<sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

<sup>15</sup> He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation.

<sup>16</sup> For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.

<sup>17</sup> And He is before all things, and in Him all things consist.

<sup>18</sup> And He is the head of the body, the church, who is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.

### **Genesis 1:26 (NKJV)**

<sup>26</sup> Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth."

### **Daniel 7:13-14 (NKJV)**

<sup>13</sup> "I was watching in the night visions, And behold, *One* like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him.

<sup>14</sup> Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, Which shall not pass away, And His kingdom the one Which shall not be destroyed.
